The January bill from Lunseth was reviewed and it was decided that loan proceeds from Farmers & Merchants State Bank would be used to pay the bill. There was brief discussion on the current Planning & Zoning Regulations that the county has, and the fact that there is no requirement for a building permit for new structures in rural Cavalier County. It was decided that this would be discussed at the township officers meeting in March, and the townships would be encouraged to implement their own zoning regulations, and the

importance of letting their assessor know when there are new structures and changes of ownership in the townships. Pam LaFrenz, Tax Director, visited with the commissioners about the possibility of doing aerial imaging of Cavalier County through the Sidwell program. Lafrenz stated she would look into what it would cost. It was decided this would be discussed at the special meeting on Tuesday, February 14th.

Ron Haugen from NDSU did a presentation on the calculation of agriculture values.

Martin Mechanical Design Inc. and Lundseth Plumbing and Heating Co. met with the commissioners and reviewed the progress of the courthouse boiler pipe project. They stated completion is still set for March 2017.

The following departments did their semi-annual reports to the commissioners: Vicki Kubat – Recorder; Cindy Stremick – Treasurer; Anita Beauchamp – Clerk of Court; Pam LaFrenz – Tax Director; and Leon Pederson – Weed Officer.

Stanley Dick made a motion, seconded by Richard Ring, to transfer \$6,395.00 from Road and Bridge Fund to Road and Bridge Equipment Replacement Fund, motion carried. Elsie Magnus made a motion, seconded by David Zeis, to transfer \$3,042.00 from Road and Bridge Fund to Road and Bridge Equipment Replacement Fund, motion carried. David Zeis made a motion, seconded by Richard Ring, to transfer \$82,643.80 from Road and Bridge Fund to Road and Bridge Excess Levy Fund, motion carried. Stanley Dick made a motion, seconded by Elsie Magnus, to transfer \$8,264.38 from Road and Bridge Fund to Road and Bridge Equipment Replacement Fund, motion carried. Richard Ring made a motion, seconded by Elsie Magnus, to transfer \$48,000.00 from County Poor Fund to Social Welfare Fund, motion carried.

The joint meeting with the commissioners, Weed Board, Water Board, ND Game & Fish, and US Fish & Wildlife scheduled for March 9, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. at the NDSU Research Center was discussed. Leon Pederson, Weed Officer, stated his board would be leading the meeting to review land stewardship practices with ND Game & Fish/US Fish & Wildlife. Pederson stated the Weed Board will have a proposal for them to contract out to the entities to provide weed control. The public will also be given the opportunity to voice any concerns on stewardship practices they have on ND Game & Fish/US Fish & Wildlife property in their area.

Bids were opened for the possible purchase of snowplow truck(s). The bids will be compiled and the commissioners decided to have a special meeting on Tuesday, February 14, 2017 to review the bids.

Terry Johnston, Road Supervisor, met with the commissioners and informed them that the state is requesting a 10% (approximately \$6,900) match on replacement of a railroad crossing on the south end of County Road 17. **Stanley Dick made a motion to approve the 10% match, seconded by Elsie Magnus, motion carried.** Johnston also reviewed the estimated cost of \$47,697.10 to order five bundles of cutting edges for each district. **David Zeis made a motion, seconded by Richard Ring, to place the order for cutting edges.** There was a roll call vote with all voting in favor.

Applications for a snowplow truck operator were reviewed. Interviews were set for Wednesday, February 15th. The motor grader operator position in the Sarles District was discussed and it was decided to put an ad in the newspaper for the position.

At 5:30 p.m., David Zeis made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Richard Ring; motion carried.

On February 14, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. the Board of Commissioners of Cavalier County, North Dakota, met at the Cavalier County Courthouse for a special meeting, with all members present. The commissioners began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Nick Moser called the meeting to order and proceeded as follows:

Pam Lafrenz, Tax Director, met with the commissioners to review a proposal from Sidwell for aerial imaging. The proposed cost for the imaging was \$73,665. The commissioners decided to see if they could find a less expensive way of updating the aerial maps.

The commissioners discussed the possibility of adding townships to the other four districts and eliminating the snowplow truck in the Langdon District. The commissioners thought this might be an option if there are new trucks in all four districts next year.

There was discussion on the requirement for the snowplow truck drivers to need a Class B Driver's License. Richard Ring made a motion, seconded by David Zeis, to give the current drivers until August 31, 2017 to get their Class B Driver's License, motion carried.

After much review and discussion on the snowplow truck bids, Stanley Dick made a motion to purchase the 2015 Caterpillar CT681 Truck for \$155,000.00 from Butler Machinery Company, seconded by David Zeis. A roll call vote was taken with all voting in favor. Richard Ring made a motion to purchase the 2018 Western Star 4700SB Truck for \$169,525.00 from Kinstle Western Star Truck Center - Wapakoneta, Ohio (delivered to Grand Forks), seconded by Stanley Dick. A roll call vote was taken with all voting in favor.

Financing options from two local banks were reviewed. Stanley Dick made a motion to use the Road and Bridge Equipment Replacement Fund balance and finance the remainder of the truck purchases with Farmers & Merchants State Bank, seconded by Richard Ring, motion carried.

At 10:50 a.m., Richard Ring made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by David Zeis; motion carried.

On February 15, 2017, at 2:00 p.m. the Board of Commissioners of Cavalier County, North Dakota, met at the Cavalier County Courthouse for a special meeting, with all members present. The commissioners began the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman Nick Moser called the meeting to order and proceeded as follows:

Interviews were conducted for the Snowplow Truck Driver for the Langdon District. There was discussion on the pros and cons of each applicant interviewed, following by a private vote. It was decided that Alexander Mikkelsen would be offered the position. Lisa Gellner, Auditor, was asked to notify the applicants.
